

Champions Club Membership Agreement

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES AND DESCRIPTIONS

THE CHAMPIONS CLUB

Champions Club members receive the most generous benefits available.

- No greens fee is charged for regular weekday and weekend play. Special events and tournaments may require additional entry fees.
- Advanced tee time restrictions may be made 30 days in advance.
- A 15% discount on Golf Shop merchandise will be honored for all members. (Charges for sale items will be either the sales discount or 15% off original price, whichever is less.)

THE LAUREL CLUB

Laurel Club members receive the same benefits as Champions Club Members with these exceptions:

- No greens fee required for regular weekday play.
- Reservations for weekday and weekend play may be made 30 days in advance.
- Members receive a 15% discount on typical weekend greens fees.

RECIPROCAL BENEFITS.

All members receive the following benefits at Windsor Parke Golf Club.

- A 15% discount on Golf Shop merchandise.
- Reservations for weekend play may be made 7 days in advance.
- Member cart fees as charged by Windsor Parke GC.

FAMILY MEMBERSHIP

Family Memberships are available for any category and allow for member privileges to be extended to the spouse and dependent children of the Member.

Dependent children are defined as a child of a member under the age of 18 years or child under the age of 22 years who is a full-time student living at home with the Member. Family members must be listed on the membership application. All charges will be billed to one Member Account.

Offer Discontinuation

The Champions Club reserves the right to limit the sale of new memberships of any kind at any time at its sole discretion.

Transfer

The membership, unless otherwise stated in this agreement, may not be resold, traded or transferred. Members may make one change to membership per year at no charge. Any additional changes require a \$200 transfer fee.

No Equity Interest

This Membership Agreement in no way grants or implies any equity interest in The Champions Club, and voting rights pertaining to Club policy, or any privileges not expressed herein.

Starting Time Cancellation

Starting time reservations may be canceled without penalty 24-hours in advance. Members who do not abide by the cancellation policy will be billed for 4 Non-member cart fees.

Adherence to Regulations

The Member agrees to abide by all Club Rules and Regulations and direction from authorized Club personnel.

Liability

Every member of the Club shall be liable for any property damage and/or personal injury at the Club or at any activity or function operated, organized, arranged or sponsored by the Club, caused by him or her, any guests or any family members. The Member agrees to pay all costs associated with this damage or injury.

Right to Regulate Facility Use

The Champions Club reserves the right to restrict the use of the Club facilities at certain times for certain events.

The Champions Club also reserves the right to schedule certain events at certain times even though Member and non-Member use may be restricted.

Member Termination

The Member may terminate this agreement at any time with written notice. The Member will still be liable for any unpaid charges, dues or initiation fees due to the Club, up to and including collection costs, attorney's fees, etc. No refund of dues or initiation will be due to the Member upon termination of the Membership.

The Club reserves the right to revise membership programs, by-laws, etc.

Champions Club members will be allowed to charge purchases and fees to the Club Account. Account charges and dues will be considered late if not paid by the end of the month in which the bill was received. A finance charge of 1.5% per month will be assessed on late accounts. Charge privileges will be suspended for accounts over 30 days late. Membership privileges will be suspended for accounts over 60 days late. Membership will be revoked for accounts over 90 days late with no refund of initiation fee or dues. All accrued past charges will be the responsibility of the delinquent member including collection costs, attorney fees, etc. Charge cards are property of the Club and may be used only by those specified on the Membership Agreement and must be returned to the Club upon request.

Club Rules and Regulations

All players must register in the Golf Shop before beginning play, whether riding or walking.

Dress Code

The following attire will not be allowed on the golf course: gym-type wear (gym shorts, tank tops, sweat pants, T-shirts, etc.), swimwear, blue jeans, athletic shoes other than golf shoes or smooth-sole tennis shoes.

Proper golf attire is required at all times, with appropriateness determined by the Golf Staff.

Non-metal or soft spikes are approved. Metal spikes are forbidden.

Golf Carts

Operators of golf carts must be at least 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license. Golf cart operation is at the risk of the operator. Any damage to any golf cart will be the financial responsibility of the operator.

Golf carts are not to be used by more than two riders and two golf bags at one time.

All golf carts must stay on paths around green and tee areas. Operators must abide by all directional signs when operating a golf cart. Please make note of the cart path conditions before play. *Walking is a limited privilege of membership and will be regulated by Club policy at all times.*

Other Regulations

- Each player must have an individual set of clubs. Rental clubs are available through the Golf Shop.
- Priority of groups is foursomes, threesomes, twosomes and singles. Groups of more than 4 have no standing and MUST be approved before starting. Fivesomes will not be allowed during peak play times.
- Allow faster players to play through. Maintain your pace with the group ahead of you. Play will be monitored by rangers who have authority to enforce slow play rules.
- Register in the Golf Shop before playing additional holes after your round.
- No food or beverages may be brought onto the grounds. Food and beverage service is available at the Club.
- No personal coolers are allowed on the course. Coolers are available at no extra charge in the grill and can be taken on the course.
- Establishment of handicaps is strongly recommended and available in the Golf Shop. An established USGA Handicap may be required for participation in certain events and tournaments.
- We encourage you to play from the tees best suited for your game to maintain proper pace and maximize your enjoyment. The Golf Staff will be glad to make recommendations.
- Do not take range balls onto the golf course. Stay behind the markers on the range tee at all times.
